

Evergreens:

* **American Arborvitae** - One of the favorite wind-break trees, it can grow 30-40' tall with a 10-15' spread. Slow to medium grower.

* **Blue Spruce** - A highly prized ornamental evergreen. Colors vary from green to blue. Grows well while young and matures at 50-75' tall with a 10-20' spread.

* **Norway Spruce** - This fast growing spruce typically grows 40-60' tall but can get to 75-100'. Has a 25-30' spread that grows well in well drained soils.

* **White Pine** - The quickest grower of the pines it typically is 50-80' tall with a 20-40' spread but can get to 150' tall in some cases. Does best in fertile, moist soil.

* **White Spruce** - This broad, dense evergreen with ascending branches reaches heights of 40-60' with 10-20' spreads. Best in moist soils with full sun/part shade.

Hardwoods:

* **Bur Oak** - Slower growing but reaches 60-80' tall. Wood used for flooring, barrels, and furniture. Excellent firewood & wildlife food source.

* **Pin Oak** - Moderately fast growing up to 60-80'. Planted for its pyramid shape and autumn scarlet red color. Acorns are great wildlife food.

* **Red Oak** - Grows on wide variety of sites. Acorns are good for wildlife. Fast growing up to 70-90ft. Fall colors range from brilliant red to brown.

* **Swamp White Oak** - Grows 50-70'. Can tolerate high moisture. Acorns eaten by a variety of wildlife.

* **White Oak** - A majestic tree valued for its timber as well as its ornamental value. It grows from 50 to 100' tall and has nearly perfect proportions. Produces an acorn crop every year.

* **Kentucky Coffee Tree** - Rapid growing and native to Iowa. A member of the Locust family, does well in landscaping. Produces a thornless pod.

Shrubs:

* **American Plum** - Small common tree found in pastures, fencerows, stream banks, etc. Also used in windbreaks. Blooms in Spring. Flowers are very fragrant. Produces a sugary, fleshy fruit and provides good cover for song and game birds.

* **Highbush Cranberry** - An attractive shrub that grows 8-10' tall. Leaves turn brilliant red and orange in the fall. A red berry fruit will last throughout the winter for wildlife, especially the birds.

* **Red Osier Dogwood** - Brilliant red stems make this 7-9' tall shrub very attractive in the winter. White blossoms are appealing in the spring and the berries it produces are sought after by many birds.

* **Silky Dogwood** - Wide spreading shrub that grows 8-10' tall. Has small white clusters of flowers in late June and produces pale-blue clusters of bitter but aromatic berries that are high in food value to wildlife.
